Removal Methods

- 1. **M** Launder with hot water
- 2. A Launder with cold water
- 3. Flush back side with cold water
- 4. Flush back side with hot water
- 5. Flush with hydrogen peroxide
- 6. ©Pretreat with stain remover
- 7. Blot with a clean rag and dish soap solution*
- 8. Properties 8. Rub the stain together with the fabric
- 9. Sprinkle with lemon juice and salt
- 10. Blot with rubbing alcohol

- 11. Air Dry (in the sun if possible)
- 12. Flush with Vinegar
- 13. Freeze
- 14. Scrape off any excess stain material
- 15. Wash with chlorine Bleach T16. Cover with Salt
- 17. Plush with paint thinner or acetone
- 18. Sprinkle with cornstarch
- 19. Blot with diluted ammonia*
- 20. A Dab with liquid laundry soap
